

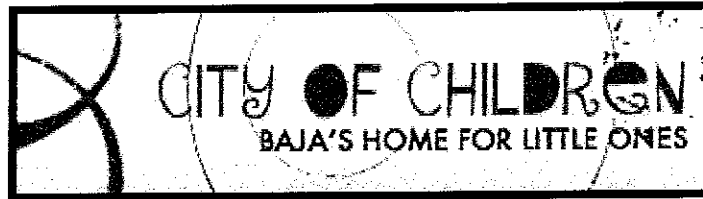

### ***What is the City of Children?***

City of Children is an orphanage which began in 1970 as a labor of love led by Earl Farmer and concerned Christian people in California - today, the City of Children continues to be a successful mission model of Churches of Christ across America.

Their purpose is to teach the gospel of our Lord to the orphaned and needy children of Mexico. Since the beginning, 620 children and adults have become Christians, with an additional 800 new christians reached through Baja Missions. The Mexican government allows us to teach the gospel because we are giving their children a good home, good care and education.

We are trying to bring love and happiness back into the lives of hurting children. One of the ways we accomplish this is through providing mission opportunities for visiting teams from Churches of Christ. The purpose of your visit is to be a friend and an example of Jesus to a child. Your hugs and attention may be the love that helps heal a broken heart. If you will reach out to the children, God will overflow your heart with blessings. When you serve a meal, give a gift or drive a nail, you are doing it for Jesus as well as a child.

All of the children at the City have a story. Most have been abandoned for some reason. Some of their parents have died; some can't afford to take care of their children or are abusive or negligent. Some of the children don't know why they are there. Most of our children are placed in our home by the Baja Welfare Department (DIF). All of them share the same sense of urgency - to love and be loved by caring Christians - and to feel the compassion of God's people.

### **What will we be doing at the City of Children**

While in Mexico at the City of Children orphanage we will be doing many different services. We will be putting on a Vacation Bible School, spending time fixing up projects at the orphanage, and spending time giving the children much needed one on one time.

On this trip we will be working with two other churches of Christ. The Roseville Church of Christ is taking the lead on this mission trip as they have been going to the City of Children for several years. The three churches will be working together to accomplish our tasks.

Along with all of our services that we will be doing on our journey we will be having a little fun ourselves. On our return trip we will be stopping at Disneyland. After the long trip and hours of service that will have been put during the previous months a time of relaxation will be well deserved. Disneyland has offered 1 million free tickets for 1 million days of service. We will be performing some of those days of service in exchange for tickets.

### **How Much Does It Cost?**

The cost is **\$300.00** per person. Fundraising opportunities will be available to raise this money. The \$300.00 includes: travel, lodging, VBS materials, and food. Each person may bring extra spending money for souvenirs from Mexico, snacks on the way down and Disneyland.

### **Travel**

Our church group will be driving vans from Keizer to San Diego. To travel to Mexico each person must have one of the three requirements met: 1. a passport, 2. a birth certificate and state issued picture ID, or 3. a passport card.

### **How do I sign up?**

This trip is for students from the Keizer Church of Christ who are at least 13 years old. To go you must complete everything on the individual responsibilities list.

### **Expectations:**

1. Hard work
2. Good attitudes
3. No electronics: iPods, CD players, video gaming, cell phones etc.
4. Follow the dress code.
5. Stay with the group at all times.
6. Follow the authority and leadership of those in charge.
7. No profanity (or sissy cussing)
8. No PDA (Public Display of Affection).
9. No use of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.

## **Individual Responsibilities**

- 1. **Day of Service:** Each person must complete one day of service in order to receive a ticket for Disneyland.
- 2. **Attendance:** Attendance at church is required. Attendance guidelines will be the same for receiving summer camp scholarships which is 75% of either Sunday morning class or Wednesday Bible Studies. In addition fund raisers and mission trip meetings must be attended.
- 3. **Fundraising:** Each person will be responsible for \$300 toward the trip. There will be plenty of fundraising opportunities to do this. If the money is not fundraised then it must come out of pocket.
- 4. **Behavior:** All rules must be followed, and the authority of the adult leaders must be respected.
- 5. **"Why I want to go on the mission trip:"** Must be completed and turned in.
- 6. **Identification Papers:** 1. passport, or 2. birth cert. and photo ID, or 3. passport card
- 7. **Student Commitment Form:** Signed and dated by both student and parents
- 8. **Minor Travel Permission Form:** Signed dated and notarized.
- 9. **Mexico Mission Medical Release and Waiver of Liability:** Completed, signed and dated.
- 10. **Team Member Application:** Completed
- 11. **Adults Only:** Adult Application Form

## MEXICO MISSION 2010 MEDICAL RELEASE & WAIVER of LIABILITY

Please read carefully. This is a legal document that affects your legal rights. Each volunteer must complete a Release Waiver and Emergency Contact form prior to travel. Thank you!

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release") executed on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2010 by \_\_\_\_\_, (the "Volunteer"), and (in the case of a minor child) \_\_\_\_\_, the parent having legal custody and/or legal guardian of the volunteer (the "Guardian"), in favor of Roseville Church of Christ, a California nonprofit organization, their directors, officers, employees and agents (collective, "Roseville").

The Volunteer (and Guardian) desires that the Volunteer works as a volunteer for Roseville during Mexico Mission 2010 and engage in activities related to being a volunteer (the "Activities") working with Roseville and the City of Children in Ensenada, Mexico. The Volunteer (and Guardian) understands that the Activities may include construction and rehabilitating residential and/or commercial buildings, working with children at the City of Children and living in housing provided for volunteers of Roseville. The Volunteer (and Guardian) hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

- 1. Release, Waiver and Discharge. Covenant not to sue.** The Volunteer (and Guardian) does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless Roseville and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arises or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with Roseville. The Volunteer (and Guardian) understands that this Release discharges Roseville from any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against Roseville with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damages that may result from Volunteer's work for Roseville, whether caused by the negligence of Roseville or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. The Volunteer (and Guardian) also understands that this Release and Waiver of Liability shall bind the members of my family including my spouse, and my heirs, assigns and/or personal representative. The Volunteer (and Guardian) also understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by Roseville in writing, Roseville does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.
- 2. Medical Treatment.** Except as otherwise agreed to by Roseville in writing, the Volunteer (and Guardian) does hereby release and forever discharge Roseville from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with Roseville or (in the case of a minor child) with the decision by any representative or agent of Roseville to exercise the power to consent to medical or dental treatment. Volunteer (and Guardian) agree any person over the age of majority acting on behalf of Roseville is empowered to do any and all things necessary in the event of any injury or sickness and is expressly authorized to enter into any and all agreements which are deemed necessary for health and well-being. Volunteer (and Guardian) consent to any x-ray, examination, anesthetic, medical, surgical or dental diagnosis, treatment and hospital care by any dentist, orthodontist, surgeon or any other physician licensed to practice in the United States or Mexico. Volunteer (and Guardian) do further authorize and empower any person over the age of majority acting on behalf of the Roseville to sign any and all medical authorizations for any such treatments or requests for payment.
- 3. Assumption of the Risk.** The Volunteer (and Guardian) understands that the Activities include work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from work sites. Volunteer (and Guardian) hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of harm in the Activities and releases Roseville from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the Activities.
- 4. Insurance.** The Volunteer (and Guardian) understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by Roseville in writing, Roseville does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance for any Volunteer. Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health and auto insurance coverage. Be advised that Mexico requires auto insurance issued by a Mexican insurance company.
- 5. Other.** The Volunteer (and Guardian) expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of California, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of California. The Volunteer agrees that in the event any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of the Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
